

- Favor internal and external communication and information related to energy efficiency, placing the company's energy policy at the disposal of the stakeholders and guaranteeing that this policy is communicated to, understood and assumed by the entire organization.
- Provide the information and human and material resources necessary for the implementation of this policy, including those necessary for the implementation of activities arising from the implemented energy management system.
- Foster training in energy management in the organization and guarantee the training of all those directly involved in the management system.
