At Indra we recognize the agreements reached at the Paris Climate Summit in 2015 and we intend to be an active agent in the collective effort to reduce the impact of Climate Change.

As part of our ongoing commitment to sustainable development, as set out in our corporate Sustainability Policy, at Indra we take on the challenge of designing and implementing technologies that help solve the defies posed by the fight against Climate Change.

To achieve this, we are committed to the development of environmentally friendly technologies and we promote innovation and investment in products and services that contribute to combat Climate Change.

The Board of Directors and the Sustainability Committee are the highest decision-making and supervisory bodies for Climate Change at Indra. In 2020 the Sustainability Committee approved an ambitious emissions reduction pathway setting science-based targets for the years 2030 and 2040 with the aim of achieving carbon neutrality by 2050.

Our goal is to move towards decarbonization of our operations and company facilities, in line with the agreements established in the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, the European Union and/or the climate targets of the governments of the countries in which we operate.

Due to our business model, the relevant sources of greenhouse gas emissions are associated with energy consumption in work centers, purchases of products and services, business travel and travel of professionals.
