## **Human Rights**

We respect the dignity and rights of all people and work proactively to prevent any abuse related to our activities or those of our partners.

Our <u>due diligence</u> is based on the Guiding Principles for Business and Human Rights of the United Nations.

Our <u>Human Rights Policy</u> last approved by the Board in 2024 reinforces our commitment to fair and inclusive development.

In 2025, we are strengthening our due diligence model in the value chain, ensuring alignment with the <u>EU Directive on</u>
Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence.

## Information Security and privacy by design
