INDRA APPOINTS ENRIQUE DE LEYVA AS INDEPENDENT DIRECTOR, AND JOSÉ ANTONIO ESCALONA DE MOLINA AS NON-VOTING SECRETARY OF THE BOARD

Madrid, April 30, 2015.- Indra's Board of Directors today agreed to appoint Enrique de Leyva Pérez as an independent director, replacing Mónica de Oriol.

- ➤ To unify Information Technologies markets under a single management area, thus enhancing the company offering and optimizing synergies. Indra Digital has been set up as a result. This new division encompasses Consulting, Analytics, Mobility, Big Data and Cyber-Security.
- ➤ To simplify and accelerate decision-making, ensuring that responsibilities in each region lie with the key businesses managers.
